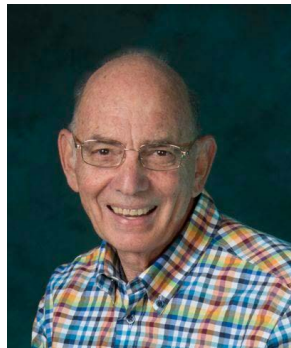




President’s Message

Renew Your Membership Now

It’s Now Online Only

Membership renewal for the 2016-2017 OLLI school year or fall 2016 semester is now online. Paper registration is no longer accepted. For those needing assistance with the new online process, help is available.

- If you have not created your OLLI student account giving you access to CSUF WiFi, then please come to the OLLI office between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. to obtain your campus-wide identification number (CWID) and PIN numbers. The office will also give you a form listing your CWID and PIN and information about how to create a student account with a username and password on the Student Portal.
- You must have your student account username and password to renew online. If you already have access to the CSUF WiFi, then you have established your OLLI student account.
- You can renew your OLLI membership online on your home computer by going to the OLLI website at <https://olli.fullerton.edu/olliregister>. The registration system will first ask you to log into the CSUF Student Portal, which will ask for your student username and password. If you don’t have those, the system will take you to the Student Portal to establish your OLLI student account.
- Once you are logged in with your username and password, the registration system brings up the membership renewal form with your name, CWID number and CSUF email address pre-entered.

-It is important that you add your personal email address. This email address will be used for all future communications from OLLI.

-The system will prompt you for information and payment by asking for your credit or debit

Concert Under the Stars

Cal State Fullerton's annual Concert Under the Stars will be held on Saturday, September 17 in the athletic field next to Gym Drive. The theme this year is "America's Bandstand." Guests will enjoy an evening of exceptional entertainment by talented students and alumni. Gates open at 5 p.m., dinner is at 6 p.m. and the concert will begin at 7:30 p.m., ending in a gala fireworks display.

This is CSUF's biggest fundraising event, and OLLI has reserved up to 25 tables that can accommodate 250 people. Available tables are subject to change.

OLLI members will have a special price of \$40 per person, part of which is going towards Student Performer Sponsorship by OLLI. Coupons for tickets are in the August ChroniCLE, and will be available in the OLLI office; you can also print ticket reservations from the OLLI News Bytes and the OLLI website. Please purchase your tickets by **Wednesday, August 17** by turning in your completed forms to the OLLI office (RGC-7). You may invite non-OLLI members to this event.

Bring a picnic dinner, or purchase food at gourmet food trucks. As before, alcoholic beverages may only be purchased on site—**no outside sources of alcohol are allowed.**

Tables will only be reserved for groups who order a table of ten (10) and list the members of the table at the time of purchase on the back side of the reservation form. Tables are limited to 10 people only. Reserved tables will cost \$400 per table. All other seating is on a first-come basis. Tickets will be available for pick up at the OLLI office during the week of the event. Pick up dates will be posted when available. No tickets will be sold at the concert. Seating is limited, so be sure to order tickets early.

A Mystery for OLLI

We have another reading group at OLLI. As our membership grows, new ideas are cultivated and new classes sprout up. The "Mystery Book Club" came about as a result of Patrick Boyle's participation in the "Alternate Mondays Book

Club" coordinated by Kitty Baier and Lisa Sewell.



The class included a couple of mystery novels. Patrick, a mystery book buff thought it would be fun to have a group that concentrated on that

particular genre, so he initiated this latest reading group on campus.

Patrick's parents were Irish immigrants from Donegal. He was born in Brooklyn, New York. He played Gaelic football on teams in North Hollywood with his father and uncle in the 1950s, and later from 1962 through 1968.

He entered the army at seventeen. By age eighteen, as a lab technician, he was teaching radar repair in Fort Monmouth, New Jersey. Three years later he went on to RCA where he taught the use of electronic test equipment. From RCA he went on to work on the Apollo project.

Teaching was an enjoyable part of his work experience, so he decided to seek an elementary teaching credential on the G.I. Bill at East Los Angeles College. While studying there he took a Special Education survey class which intrigued him. Eventually he earned both Elementary and Special Education credentials. That led to 30 years as a Special Education teacher for the orthopedic handicapped students at Rio Hondo College.

In retirement he found time for golf and addressing the "Honey Do" list at home. He began barbershop style singing on Friday afternoons in the backroom of Giovanni's Restaurant on Euclid Ave. in Fullerton. During a break one day, fellow singer, Pete Saputo informed Patrick of the OLLI program.
