Mentors serve a vital role in every CSUF Entrepreneurship class. In our consulting classes, students form teams to complete a comprehensive consulting report for a client and the mentor is with them throughout the semester helping them apply what they are learning in the classroom with the client's real-life situation. In our new venture courses, mentors help their student teams in the creation of a business plan and, hopefully, in the actual launch of a business.

Mentors are asked to virtually attend class approximately ten times over the course of the semester for about an hour each time (each professor has unique expectations). In addition to the in-class

mentoring, mentors will sometimes be called on to help students outside of class, usually by email or a phone call. Also, mentors are invited to meetings with clients. Being a mentor is a rewarding experience as mentors get to see the growth in their students from the start of the semester to the end.
