## THE BROAD & THE MOCA - MODERN ART in Los Angeles



Can't make much sense of modern art? Neither can we. So, please join us for visits, including docent led tours, to the two leading contemporary art museums in Southern California.

The Broad's distinctive museum building is home to 2,000 works of art collected by philanthropists Eli and Edythe Broad. The collection is among the most prominent holdings of postwar and contemporary art worldwide, including works by Jasper Johns, Robert Rauschenberg, Cy Twombly. Roy Lichtenstein, Ed Ruscha, Andy Warhol, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Kara Walker, Keith Haring, and Jeff Koons. Warning: some of the pieces on display are explicit.

The Museum of Contemporary Art, just across the street from The Broad, is the only artist-founded museum in Los Angeles. The MOCA houses a collection of 7,000 items of modern art, in all media, and has a history of ground-breaking, historically-significant exhibitions of art created after 1940.

Between our morning and afternoon museum visits, we will eat a late lunch on our own in one of the many restaurants on the block of Grand Avenue on which both museums are located.
