# Parking shortage should lessen in spring semester

Lower spring semester University student enrollment should partially offset 500 fewer spaces in Parking Lot E during parking structure construction.

Construction of the new parking structure will continue through the spring semester, and the University expects it will be complete before the end of summer.

OLLI parking permits are not valid in Lot E (unless an assisted parking attendant park your vehicle for you), and permits are valid in Lot D only on Fridays.

During the first month, consider arriving no later than 8:30 a.m., particularly during the peak attendance days of Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. After the first month parking spaces should be readily available in Lot G up to 9 a.m., and in Lot A at later times.

The OLLI Trolley will continue service to Lots G and A, located along Yorba Linda Blvd, and for the pick-up/drop-off point for the off-campus (EvFree) shuttle.

Assisted parking, or double ("stacked") parking by attendants, is available for surface Lots G, A, A-South, College Park South and Titan Hall. Lots G and A are located along Yorba Linda Blvd.

The CSUF off-site parking structure at EvFree Fullerton

campus was a popular option for OLLI members last semester; members found it easy to use and wait times for shuttles was minimal.

OLLI parking permits are valid at the off-site parking structure next to the First Evangelical Free Church on N. Brea Blvd. (2801 N Brea Blvd.), just north of E. Bastanchury Road. Parking is allowed on levels 2 and 3, Monday through Thursday (not Friday), from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

CSUF provides free shuttle service between the EvFree parking structure and the campus near the Parking & Transportation Office on State College Blvd.

Lot G has quite a few disabled person parking spaces, located just across West Campus Drive from the stadium entrance, where an OLLI Trolley stop is located. It turns out those spaces are almost never used.

#### **Eight Parking Tips**


- 1. Arrive on campus before 8:30 a.m. during the first month of classes.
- 2. Members with late morning or early afternoon classes on peak days should consider carpooling or ride-hailing services such as Uber and Lyft, or using the EvFree Church parking structure.
- 3. Park off campus. Try the EvFree Church parking structure and its shuttle to campus. The structure is regularly patrolled. Shuttle vehicles run continuous loops to and from the campus from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- 4. Expanded OLLI Trolley service includes Friday hours and connection to the EvFree shuttle drop-off/pickup stop on the westside of the campus with the RGC. Check the OLLI website or Shapiro lobby electronic message board for times.
- be available to members who organize carpools consisting of three or more members. The spaces are reserved in OLLI parking Lot J on the east side of the Ruby Gerontology Center. This lot fills up quickly on Tuesdays and Thursdays after 8:30 a.m. (and other times/days). Application forms are available on the OLLI website and in the OLLI Office (Room 7).

- 6. Valet style "assisted parking" is available Monday through Thursday in lots A, A-South, E, G, College Park South, and Titan Hall. Assisted (or "stacked") parking allows vehicles to park behind other cars after all spaces in a parking lot have been filled, increasing the amount of cars able to park in each parking lot.
- 7. By using their @csu.fullerton.edu" email address and password, OLLI members can register for the CSUF Titan Waze Carpoolers

Group encompassing University students, staff and faculty. Waze connects drivers and passengers from similar destinations with similar schedules by pairing them together to share campus commutes on the most optimal routes. Through the Waze Carpool app, users can choose a rider or driver based on their personal profile. Waze Carpool users may choose the days and times they want to carpool, and schedule rides up to seven days in advance. Suggested fees paid by riders to drivers are generated by the Waze app. This program is in addition to
