Objective

Create a serene, snowy landscape using a limited palette. Techniques incorporated will include: wet on wet, wet on dry, dry brush to create birch trees, and hard and soft edges. A discussion of composition, perspective, and light will be included.

Supplies

2 – 1/8 sheets of Arches 140 lb. watercolor paper (preferably rough but smooth is ok) Note: You may work on a quarter sheet if you enlarge the attached drawing.

Burnt Sienna and French Ultramarine Blue

Two medium round brushes and about a half-inch flat brush

The usual watercolor supplies.

Preparation

Copy the supplied drawing or sketch one of your own of a similar nature before class.
