Founded in 1992, the Japanese American National Museum (JANM) is in Little Tokyo, Los Angeles. As part of the Smithsonian Affiliations Program, JANM covers more than 130 years of Japanese American history. Exhibits share stories and artifacts of the Issei, Nisei, and Sansei generations of Japanese in the United States. Although books and movies tell the story of the Japanese Americans who were unjustly uprooted to relocation centers during World War II, the museum captures the impact on the Japanese culture, community, and future generations of Japanese Americans.

Many restaurants in Little Tokyo feature traditional Japanese food. Before signups begin, we will provide menus for OLLI members to review.
