Join us for an engaging field trip that dives into the Santa Ana River, often referred to as the worst flood hazard west of the Mississippi, yet it serves as the primary water source for Orange County.

- Our tour highlights Orange County's water management system, beginning at the Prado Dam and nearby wetlands, then visiting Anaheim's recharge basins and inflatable dam, and concluding at the award-winning Groundwater Replenishment System in Fountain Valley, which turns treated wastewater into drinking water. Along the way, we'll explore flood control, groundwater recharge, water recycling, and the effects of this year's heavy rains.

This field trip is organized by OLLI member Pete Saputo, a graduate of Cal State Fullerton's Hydrology Program and a former member of the Wastewater Management Board for the City of Riverside.
