iTunes Match

iCloud Music Library

Purchased

Apple Music

Sync from iTunes (this one is free)

iTunes Match

\$25 / year service

Anything in your iTunes Library on your computer is analyzed

If Apple has them in the iTunes store they will let you stream them to your Music app

If Apple doesn't have it.

Apple uploads up to 100,000 songs to your iCloud Music Library and allows you to stream them to your Music app

Apple Music

3 months free then \$10/mo or \$15/mo/family

Does not include iTunes Match
