Five Open House Tips

- 1. You can join OLLI today. Enrollment specialists will help you in Room 19. Annual membership for three semesters is \$290. Fall-only membership is \$160. Some courses, such as Ceramics and Music, will collect lab fees at a later date.

- Restrooms are outside the Auditorium building and inside the Shapiro Wing.
- 4. Avoid the lineup for lunch by visiting our exhibits till noon. While lunch service begins at 11:00 a.m., you can avoid the "first rush" lineup by touring our exhibits and entertainment areas for an extra half hour. Later can be "faster." We have plenty of food.

OLLI FACTS

- 1. Our annual membership fee covers all 100 classes and activities. Some classes have material fees. There are additional costs for day and overnight trips, as well as some social events. These fees are listed in our Course Catalog ("Blue Book") and the fall semester Schedule of Classes.
- 2. A campus parking permit is included with without addi-tional charge. Not only is it valid at most CSUF student park- ing lots and structures, the permit entitles you to park in Lot J, which is reserved for OLLI members. We also operate the OLLI Trolley transporting members between parking Lot A & G (south of Yorba Linda Bl.) to the RGC "front door."
- 3. Our classes are taught by our talented members, CSUF faculty and staff, including other subject matter experts recruited by our class coordinators.
- 4. There are no educational pre-requisites to join or attend any of our classes. "No stress" lifelong learning means no tests, no grades or attendance requirements.
- OLLI members can audit regular CSUF classes at no extra charge with the instructor's permission (mainly granted on a space available basis).
