• President Issues Statement on Relocation

President Rochon adopted the Task Force's first set of recommendations regarding a possible future relocation of OLLI. These approved recommendations reflect careful discussion and a strong commitment to OLLI, student success and the university's continued enrollment growth. • Increased Meeting Schedule

Because of the significance of this process, the Task Force has increased its cadence and will be meeting twice in January. This will allow us to move more efficiently through the work ahead and keep momentum strong.

• Extended Time in the Ruby Gerontology Center

We are also pleased to share that CSUF and OLLI have agreed to extend shared use of the Ruby Gerontology Center through spring 2027. This effectively moves us beyond the originally discussed June 2026 timeline, ensuring stability for OLLI classes and activities while long-term options are fully evaluated.
