## Sidecar Using an iPad as a display for your Mac

  - Most Mac introduced in 2016 and later
  - iPads
    - Pro all models
    - iPad (6th gen or later)
    - iPad mini (5th gen or later)
    - iPad Air (3rd gen or later)

## Sidecar Using an iPad as a display for your Mac

- Can be wireless or cabled (use a cable to charge the iPad either to the Mac or to a charger)
- To Move a Mac Window to your iPad
  - Hold pointer over the full screen button  of a window on your Mac and choose to move that window to you iPad
- After the first one you can either repeat it or drag the window to the iPad

## Sidecar

- Some apps will allow you to use an Apple Pencil 2 on the iPad to control the app
- The Sidebar at the left of the iPad will give you some controls such as;
  - Display a keyboard
    - Give you Control, Option and Command Keys and undo
  - Disconnect the iPad from the Mac
  - Hide the dock
  - Hide the menu bar in full screen mode

## Sidecar

- Slide up from under the iPad screen to hide the sidecar
- Tap the  icon in the dock to go back to the sidecar
- Tap the  icon in the sidecar sidebar and tap disconnect to close the sidebar

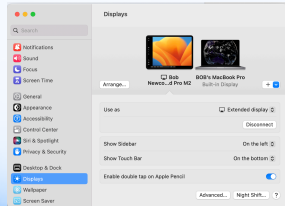
## Sidecar

- Mirroring the Mac screen
  - Choose mirroring option from the Screen Mirroring menu  in the menu bar (differs in older OS versions)

## Sidecar Settings

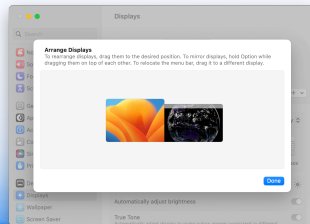
- Mac OS Ventura - Choose  → Systems Settings, click Displays in the sidebar and click the iPad

- Click the Arrange button and you can, if needed, move the iPad to the correct position in relation to the Mac Monitor
